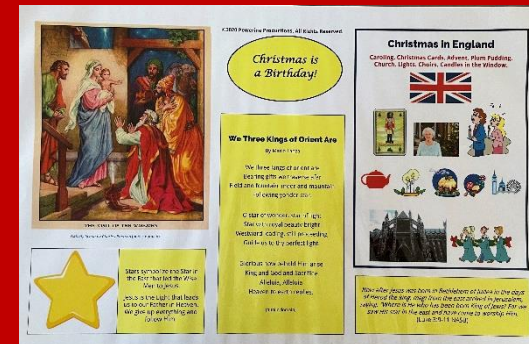

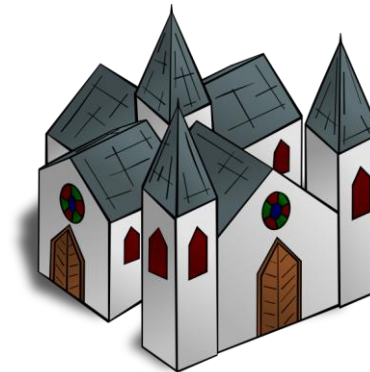


Angels symbolize the messengers from Heaven who announced the birth of Jesus to Mary and sang at the Baby Savior's birth!

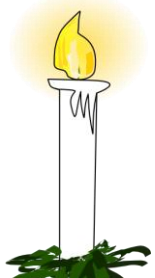
Joy to the world the Lord has come!

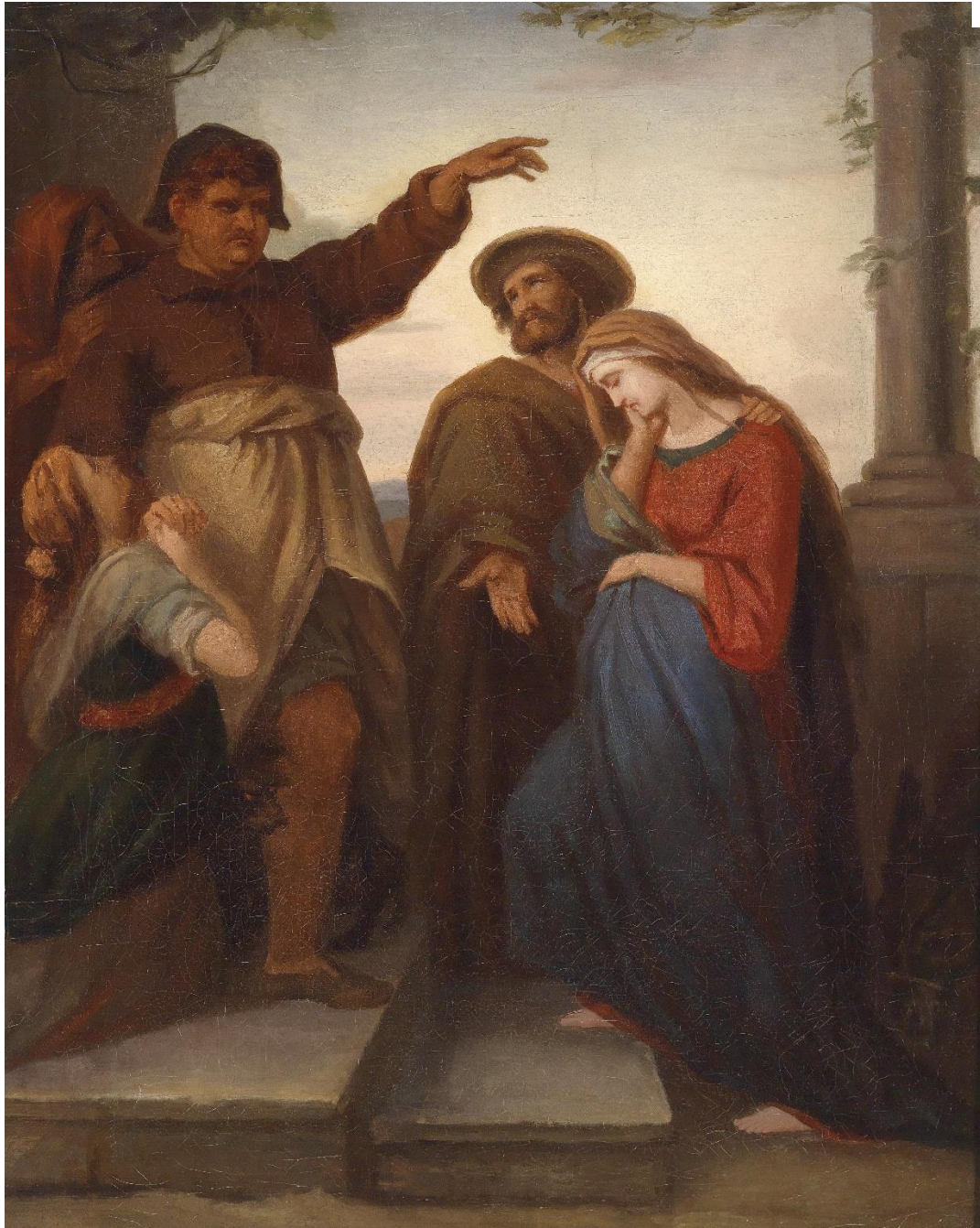

The hopes and fears of all the years are met in thee tonight

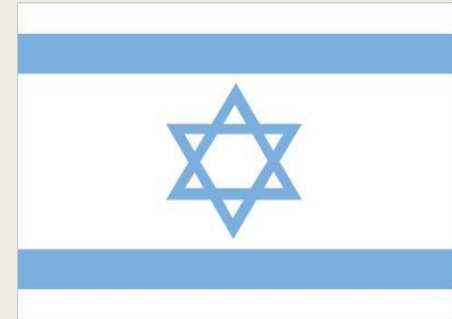
How silently, how silently, the wondrous gift is given

more may die

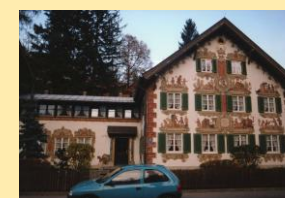
Born to raise the sons of earth, born to give

Away in the Manger

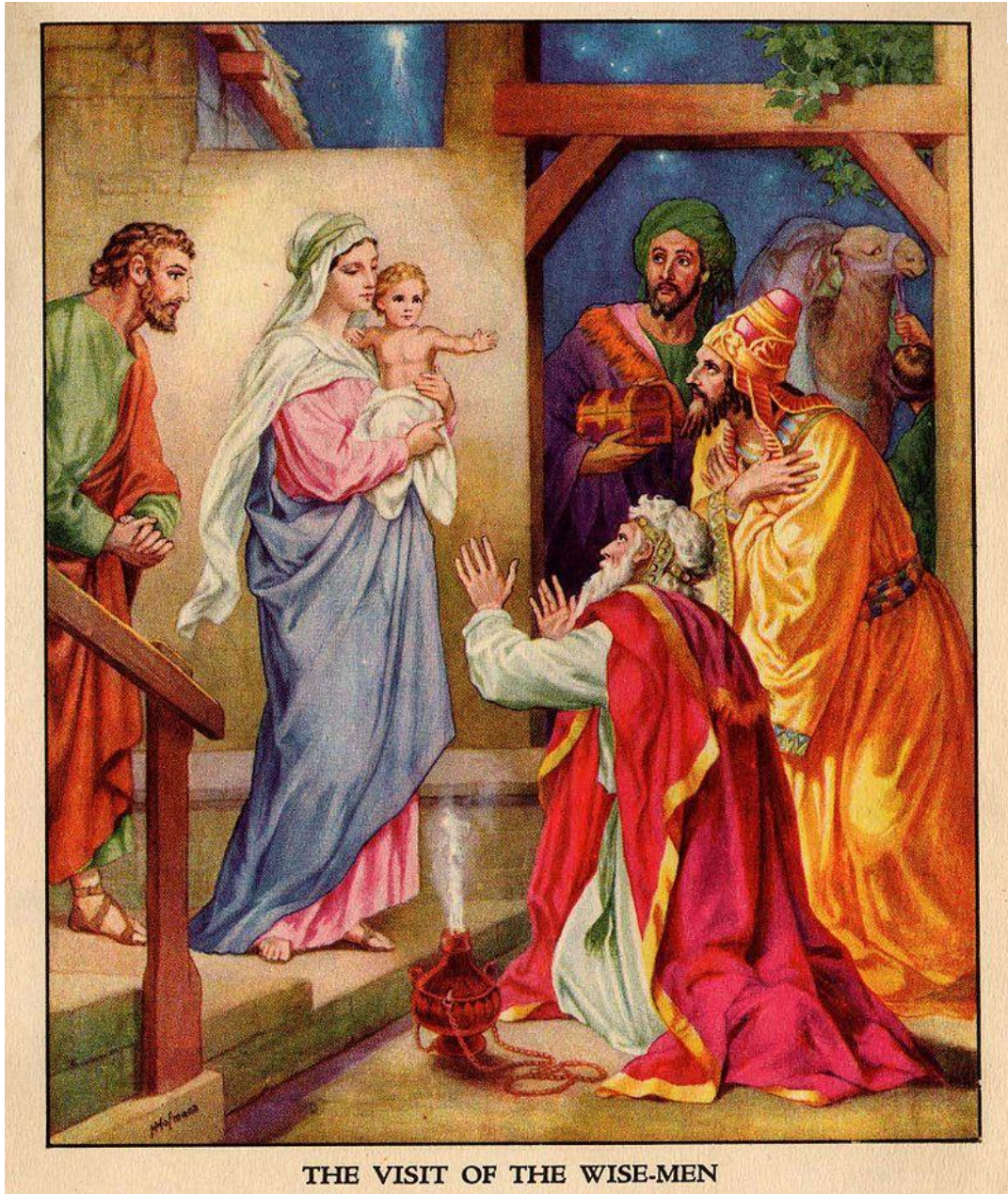
Traditional German Christmas Carol

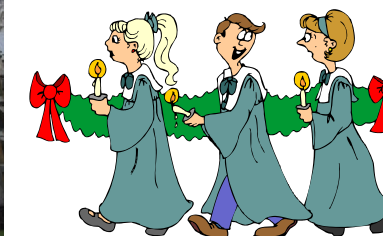
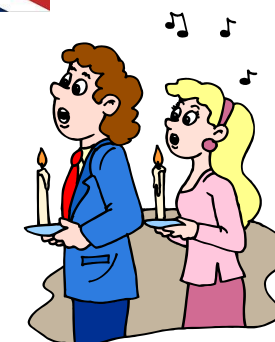


Stars symbolize the Star in the East that led the Wise Men to Jesus.

Silent night, holy night, Son of God, love's pure light

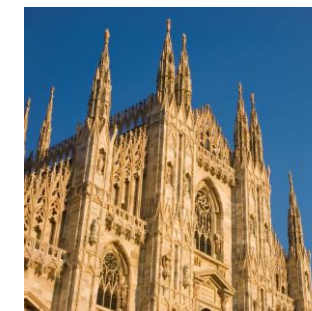
Radiant beams from Thy holy face with the dawn of redeeming grace
